



Robert Maher Memorial Scholarship Application Sponsored by Savannah River Remediation-SRS 2010 Academic Year

Purpose

To award annually a scholarship to a student who has demonstrated outstanding college level academic achievement in nuclear science/engineering. Scholarship amount that will be awarded is **\$5,000**.

Scholarship Eligibility

- Candidate must be enrolled as a junior or senior in a university or college within the states of South Carolina or Georgia.
- Candidate must have a “B” average overall grade and a “B” average in science/engineering and mathematics, as a minimum, for college level course work.
- Candidate must be pursuing a B.S. degree in nuclear science, nuclear engineering, or an engineering or science discipline, which is directly related to the nuclear field. Examples include: chemistry or chemical engineering, environmental science or environmental engineering, nuclear materials, etc. The candidate may demonstrate their interest and involvement in the nuclear field by describing a summer research project or their junior/senior thesis topic (see page 3).
- Candidate must be a U.S. Citizen.

Financial Need

Financial need will be considered. The candidate may submit evidence of unmet need as part of the application.
